# Activities

All activities are run by Cataract Scout Park Activity Leaders. You can choose from the following 7 activities;

## **Waterslide**

A 40 meter slide, through a beautiful bush setting, is one of our most popular activities.

**Closed between: 30<sup>th</sup> April – 28<sup>th</sup> September.**

## **Challenge Valley**

An Army styled obstacle course with 15 different elements ranging from rope climbing, suspended ladders, water holes and mud pits. Each participating person is required to bring the following items; **old clothes and shoes.**

## **Caving**

A man made maze of caves with tight vertical squeezes, crawl through, chimney climbs and large open chambers with escape hatches. Each participating person is required to bring the following items; **a torch, old clothes and shoes.**

## **Low Ropes Course**

A huge variety of challenging elements suspended one foot above the ground excellent for team work, communication, leadership and confidence building.

## **Orienteering**

Learn the basics of map reading and navigation, two challenging courses available in a semi dense bush environment. **Junior** ages **6 –10** introduction to map reading.

**Senior** ages **11 & up** more intense map reading and compasses.

## **Pioneering**

Learn the basics of knot tying while building chariots, bridges, and ballisters. Great for teamwork, communication, leadership and co-operation skills.

## **Rock Climbing Wall**

Learn the basics of climbing with a safety mat.
